



33 questions on status of IWRM implementation


Number of reports submitted 171

Total number of datasets for analysis 186 (including 2017 baseline reports without an update)



Main findings I

- Increase in the global average score from 49% (2017) to 54% (2020) out of 100
- Global average changed from Medium-low to Medium-high




Main findings II


- Implementation levels are lowest in Latin America and the Caribbean, Oceania, Central and Southern Asia, and Sub-Saharan Africa

- Financing still the lowest scoring dimension
- The most commonly cited barriers to IWRM implementation:
- Political will and commitment
- Lack of coordination;
- Insufficient financing;
- Weak capacity;
- Insufficient monitoring;
- Ineffective legal frameworks;


Key messages



1. Globally, the rate of implementation of IWRM urgently needs to double



2. Real and rapid progress is possible



3. Business as usual is not an option



Carry out the Action Plan to ensure measurable progress on SDG 6.5.1 and other SDG targets, feeding back into the reporting process (stage 1)






